

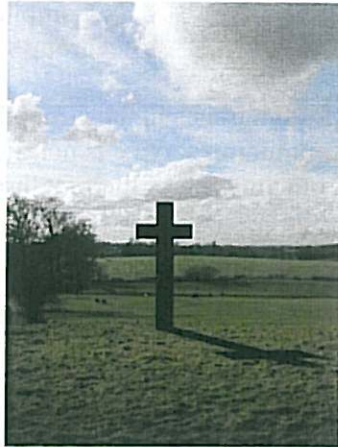
### Who is “in charge” and how to make contact?

## What is Woodbridge?

The Woodbridge Group of Churches is the new group of six churches to the east and south east of Malmesbury. The area of the six parishes which make up the Woodbridge Group is not named on any map, but is named after the Woodbridge Brook which runs through the area.



## Who are we?

The Woodbridge Group of Churches includes Brinkworth, Dauntsey, Garson, Great Somerford, Lea and Cleverton and Little Somerford. It has been formed from parts of three earlier benefices in the North Wiltshire Deanery of the Diocese of Bristol.

## Where are we now?

We currently have a vacancy for a new vicar to oversee the Woodbridge Group of Churches. An advert and person specification are currently being drafted for approval by the Diocese. If everything proceeds smoothly, we hope to be advertising the vacancy around Easter 2013.

## How did we get here?

In 2003 the Diocese of Bristol started planning to form the Woodbridge Group, as part of a major restructuring of providing ministers within the Church of England, the work to form the group formally started in 2005.

As our last two vicars, Reverend Derek Ormston from Brinkworth and Dauntsey and Reverend Canon Richard East from Lea, Garson and Charlton, have retired, the Woodbridge Group is now ready to be legally formed

## The new service pattern

As we do not currently have a vicar, the service pattern across the Group has had to change.

1st Sunday	)
2nd Sunday	) Arranged individually for each of the churches
3rd Sunday	)
4th Sunday	Combined Worship with Communion at one of the churches in the group
5th Sunday	Combined Worship at one of the churches in the group

Most churches in the Group have services on each Sunday, and a communion service is normally provided at two of the churches in the group on each of the first three Sundays.
