Developing an understanding of different religions helps us understand the world we live in. Over the next few weeks we will be looking at Sikhism and Hinduism.

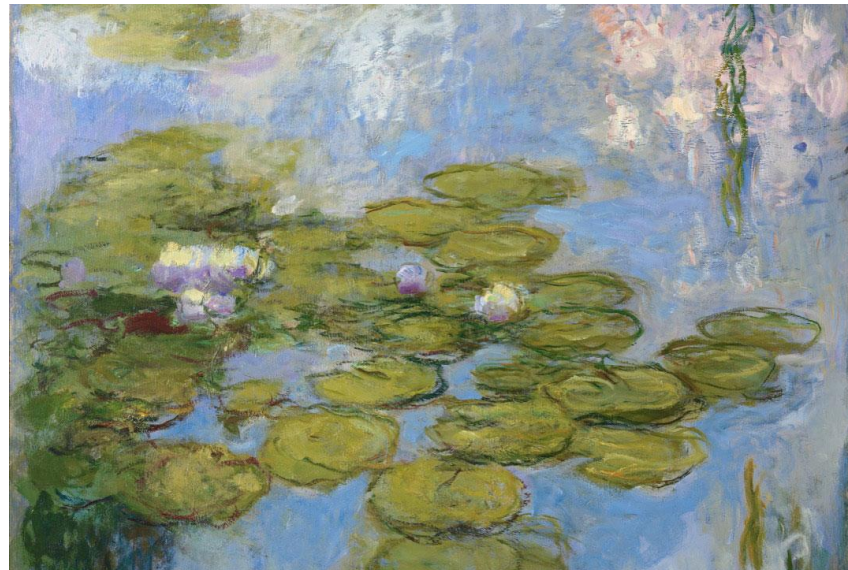
In this lesson we will be learning all about how the religion of Sikhism began with its founder Guru Nanak
