9.25 - 10.25 English



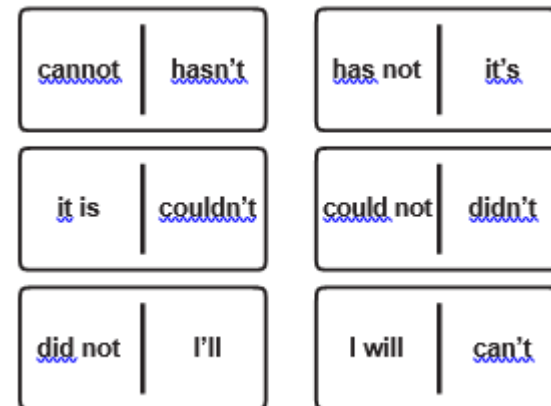
- ▶ WALT: retrieve information

Make sure you have spelt each word correctly!



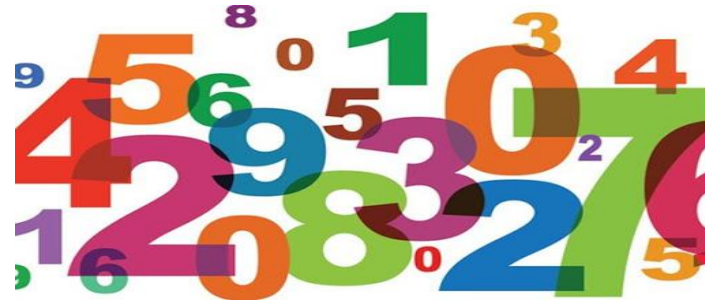
10.40 - 11.00 Playtime!
