2. Now write a sentence to explain what each word means- remember your capital letters and full stops.

3. Practise spelling each word again 3 times using the LSCWCh (Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check) method.

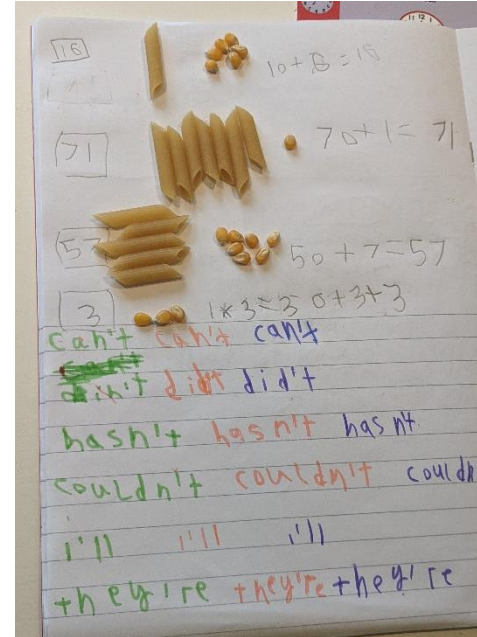
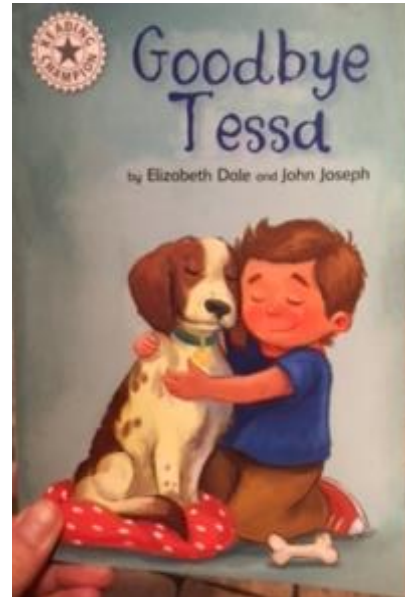
