## 9.30 - 9.45 Phonics



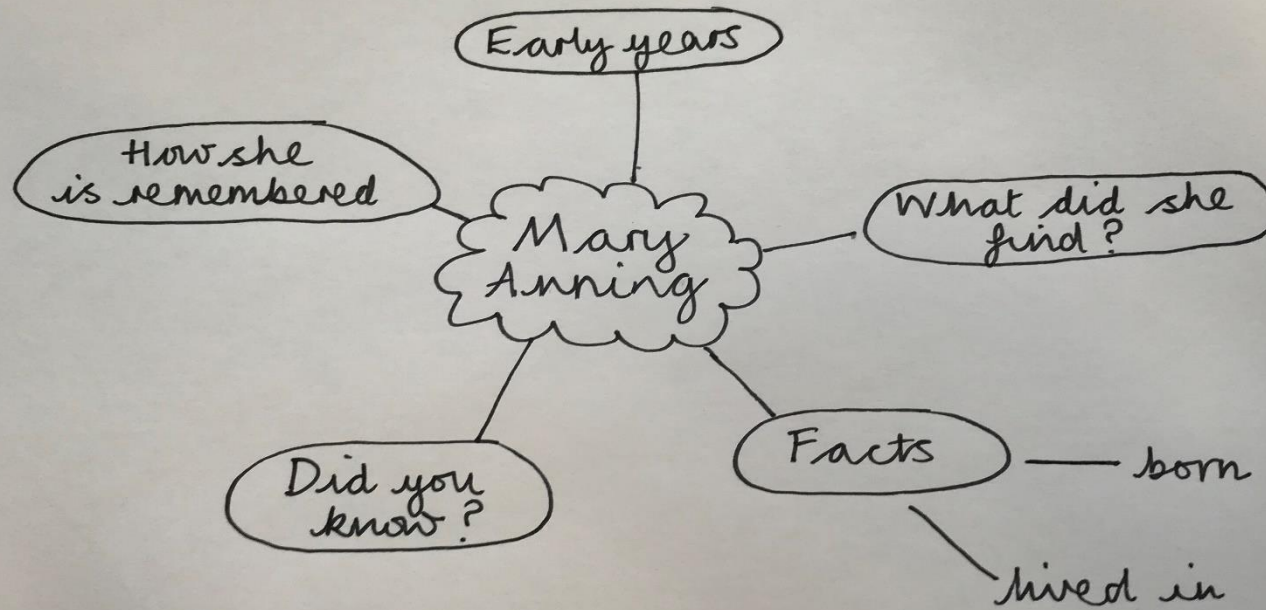
WALT spell the phoneme 'ore'

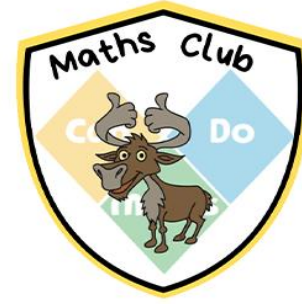
