# 9.30 - 9.45 Phonics



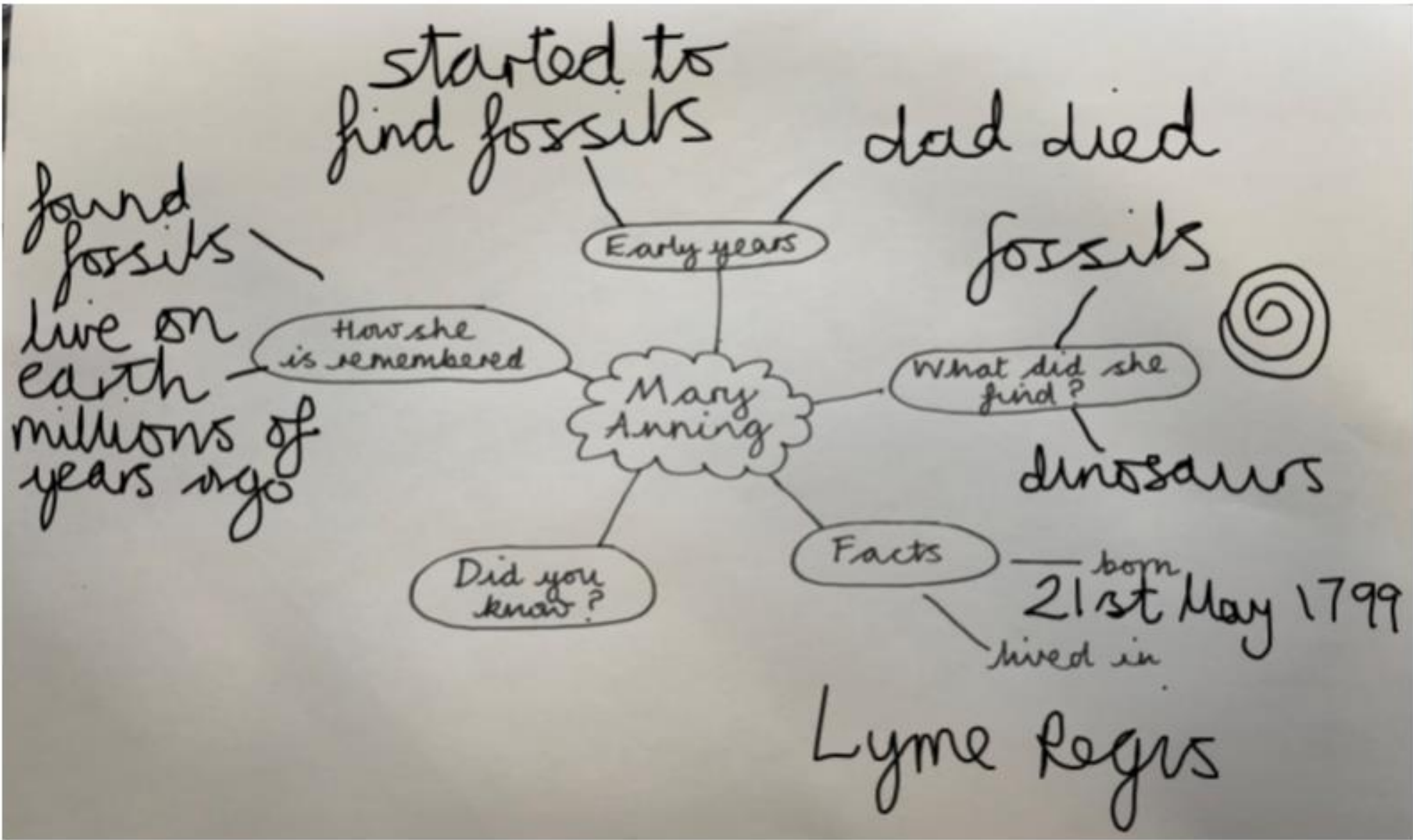
WALT spell the phoneme 'igh'

- ▶ You will need some paper and a pencil.

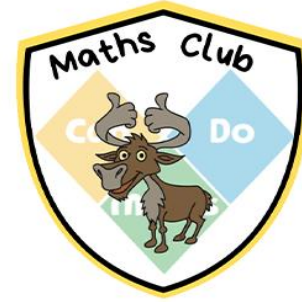
