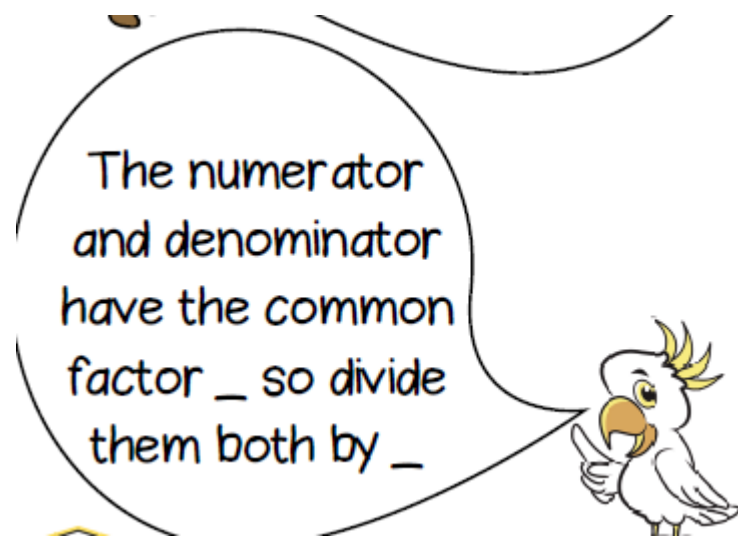

Maths - Simplify Fractions

Today we are looking at simplifying fractions and how we can use our knowledge of common factors to help.

The common facts of 12 and 8 are 1, 2 and 4. Therefore we can simplify the fraction $\frac{8}{12}$ to $\frac{4}{6}$

or $\frac{2}{3}$



Use common factors to simplify fractions

Simplify fully:

$$\frac{4}{10} \quad \frac{9}{15}$$
$$\frac{6}{8} \quad \frac{15}{60}$$
$$\frac{12}{18}$$

Coco thinks that she has simplified:

$$\frac{3}{10} = \frac{1.5}{5}$$

Explain why she is incorrect.
