English

Our class book this term is 'Grandad's Island' by Benji Davies. This story will inspire us to write our own stories. We will also look at recounts and explore features of both Fiction and Non Fiction texts. We will also spend some time looking at poetry based around the book.

In phonics, we will be using the Little Wandle scheme for our daily input. Following the scheme, pupils will be encouraged to segment and blend their sounds.

RF

This term Oak class will be exploring 'Who made the world?' During this term we will be exploring how the world was created. This is a great opportunity to share our own thoughts and beliefs.

Computing

This term the children will be thinking about staying safe online

Science

The children will be looking at the Seasons this term. They will name four seasons and identify when in the year they occur.

They will observe and describe weather in different seasons.

They will describe days being longer in summer and shorter in winter. They will also present data in tables and charts.

Maths

This term we are covering three units. Our first unit will be focusing on place value up to 20 - representing numbers and understanding the structure of sequencing numbers, counting forwards and backwards and identifying one more/one less and number representation - numerals and written numbers. Our second unit will be exploring geometry - properties of 2D shapes. Our final unit will be focusing on addition and subtraction and investigating number bonds to help us to develop our number fluency through addition and subtraction. We will also be creating number sentences using + - =. As part of Maths Mastery we will encourage the class to use visual representation - half whole models, number lines, ten frames,

History

We will think about how we have grown and changed over time.

We will then be thinking about what the past means and looking at events / toys from 'Living Memory'. We will also look at homes that reflect times in which they were built and look at how they have changed in different times in history

Art

This term we will be introduced to our new sketch books and begin to develop our drawing skills. We will then look at colour mixing and reflect on the work of Kandinsky.

PE

Gymnastics-explore movements inspired by animals. Multi-skills with Steven.

PSHE

Our focus this term is 'Me and My Relationships - Feelings and Emotions'- understanding why we feel different emotions and how we can support others.
