English

Our class book will be 'How to Live Forever.' We will plan and write a tragedy and create a newspaper report based on this story. We will look at what makes a good sentence focusing on fronted adverbials and expanded noun phrases. In poetry lessons we will write our own humorous poems. We will have a daily guided reading session based on 'Sky Song' and spelling lessons. We will also be working on developing our handwriting and presentation skills.

Computing

Science

Maths
