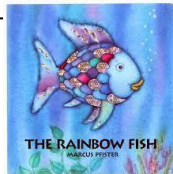
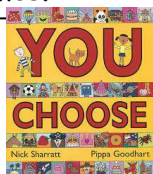
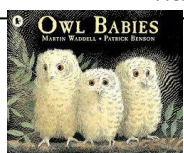
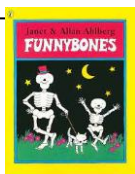


Literacy, Communication and Language

Throughout this term, Beech class will be participating in activities which link to our core texts. These books have been chosen for our termly theme - 'Marvellous Me'. During our first term we will be starting our phonics journey. Phonics will be taught daily - learning a new sound (phoneme) and looking and practising the way the sound is written (grapheme). As the journey moves forwards we will continually revisit and review sounds and tricky words. We will also be focusing on name recognition and writing our names.



Maths

Beech class will be encouraged to focus on counting this term using concrete resources e.g counting objects, actions and sounds in addition to counting what we can see and what we can't see and finding totals up to 6 by exploring partitioning. As part of Maths we will encourage pupils to use their subitising skills when identifying a set of objects up to 10 and find out what is a shape?



PE/ Physical Development

Beech class will have two sessions of P.E a week. Miss Mewis will be teaching our P.E focus 'Moving in different ways' on Fridays. On Wednesdays this term, Coach Steven will be teaching ball control. The children will also participate in activities throughout the day focusing on developing their fine motor skills.



Expressive Arts and Design

Children will draw themselves and their family members in addition to drawing pictures of familiar things. They will use construction materials to make objects of interest. They will learn to use some tools, media and mediums independently to express themselves.
