

English

In English this term we will be reading a story called 'The Wishing Tree' we will use this story to make up our own stories about making a wish. We will also be looking at report writing within Non Fiction texts and writing poems about Nature.

In phonics, we will be using the Little Wandle scheme for our daily input. Following the scheme, pupils will be encouraged to segment and blend their sounds.

This term Oak class will be thinking about the Christmas story and why it is important to Christians.

Computing

This term the children will be learning how to use <https://paintz.app/> to create pictures.

Science

The children will be learning about animals including humans. We start the term by looking at our bodies and labelling body parts. We will then think about our 5 senses. This will include experiments that will allow us to explore smell and taste. We will try a variety of food and decide if it is sweet, salty, bitter or sour. Towards the end of term we will think about animals and what they eat. We will also learn the vocabulary - herbivore, carnivore and omnivore.



Maths

Our main focus areas for term 2 is:
Number and place value up to 100, addition and subtraction facts up to 10 and geometry exploring 3D shapes. As part of the maths mastery approach, we will be exploring all mathematical concept using the concrete, pictorial and aspect method.
