English

In English this term we will be reading the traditional tale' Jack and the Beanstalk. We will use the story to retell and write our own stories. We will also be exploring letter writing, leaflets and posters. Towards the end of the term we will then move onto poetry. We will focus on the poem 'What is Pink?' by Christina Rossetti.

In phonics, we will be using the Little Wandle scheme for our daily input. Following the scheme, pupils will be encouraged to segment and blend their sounds.
