English

In English this term we will be reading 'Wendal's Workshop' and completing a variety of written activities inspired by the text. Our non-fiction writing, will involve reading instructional texts and then writing instructions of our own. At the end of term, we will be focusing upon humorous poetry.

In phonics, we will be using the Little Wandle scheme for our daily input. Following the scheme, pupils will be encouraged to segment and blend their sounds.

R.E.

This term Oak class will be thinking about Easter and why Easter matters to Christians. They will be thinking about hope and new beginnings.

Computing

This terms unit introduces children to data and information through labelling, grouping and searching.

Science

The children will learn about 'Materials'. They will be learning to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made, identify and name a variety of everyday materials including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock, describe the simple properties of a variety of everyday materials and compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple properties.

Maths

Our main focus for Term 4 is:

Partitioning numbers from 16 to 20, recognising and identifying addition and subtraction facts. We will also be recognising a half and quarter of objects and shapes and finding a half and a quarter of objects and amounts.
