### Daily homework: reading

Draw some animals and label them in French. We will be learning the names in our French lessons.

Draw a character/animal from the rainforest and find out some information about them. Present it however you would like—poster, leaflet, powerpoint, etc.

Practise telling the time on an analogue clock.

Write a story about some of the animals in the rainforest. Remember to use capital letters, full stops and imaginative language.

Make a leaflet explaining to your friends how to stay safe online.

Create a piece of artwork or collage to represent what humans need to eat to stay healthy.
