In English, we will be continuing with our core text 'Letters from a lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. We will use this text to inspire our own tragic tale. For non-fiction, we will be drafting and editing a recount of events in chronological order. For Poetry, we will be looking at ballads and the way lyrics and language impact emotion. For guided reading, we will complete our core text, whilst also exploring a range of smaller extracts. These smaller extracts will help build our understanding of a text and our ability to look beyond what is written to infer information. We will also have daily spelling lessons and we will continue to develop our grammatical understanding and implementation.

Computing
