English

In English this term we will be reading 'The Girl and the Dinosaur' and completing a variety of written activities inspired by the text. Our non-fiction writing, will involve learning about the features of recounts and writing our own recounts. We will also be reading a variety of 'list poems' and then writing our own 'list poems'.

In phonics, we will be using the Little Wandle scheme for our daily input. Following the scheme, pupils will be encouraged to segment and blend their sounds.
