English

Our writing this term will be based on the book 'Just a dream' by Chris Van Allsburg. We will use the story to write our own stories with a moral during our fiction writing. Our non-fiction writing will take on the form of instruction writing. Towards the end of term we will exploring songs with lyrics. During our daily whole-class guided reading sessions we will be looking at the story 'The Riddle of the runes' and developing our skills in looking closely at a text. We will have daily spelling lessons and we will also be working on developing our handwriting and presentation skills.

Maths

Our main focus in Maths will be calculating fractions and reading, representing, ordering and comparing numbers with more than one decimal place.

We will also be securing our times table knowledge in preparation for the MTC.

History

This term we will be learning all about the Ancient Egyptians. The children will be learning all about mummification, Egyptian Gods and Goddesses, the Egyptian creation story and will be practicing hieroglyphics.

Art

This term we will explore 3D form and make sculptures using modroc. We will explore artists who make sculptures of food and work in our
