Create a friendship flower (like the one in the picture below) about how to be a good friend.



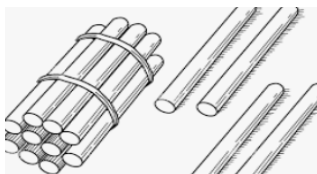
## English
