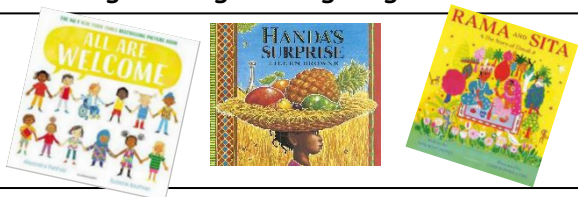


Literacy, Communication and Language

Following our termly theme 'All around the world' we will be exploring a mixture of both fiction and non-fiction text. Understanding non-fiction text allows us to gain information. We will encourage all the pupils to be inquisitive by asking questions to learn and share new and prior knowledge.

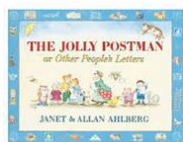
Naturally through this term we will be learning new vocabulary and its meaning.

Our daily phonics lessons will continue, focusing on revisiting sounds, learning new sounds and really embedding our sound talk and blending, and using our segmenting fingers to write words.



Maths

This term we will be focusing on numbers 7 to 10 and using concrete resources to make sets and sorting objects into groups of a particular quantity. In helping to develop number fluency we will encourage the children to use their subitizing skills at much as possible. We will also focus on number patterns and 2D shapes.



PE/ Physical Development

This term Stephen will continue to teach ball skills focusing on catching, throwing and aiming at a distance. Miss Mewis will be focusing on developing our co-ordination. This will consist of developing our co-ordination through dance. Throughout the term we will be encouraging and promoting the skills of both gross and fine motor to help to develop our dexterity using one-handed tools.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will be participating in a wide variety of activities which will enable us to be creative through music, dance and, of course, arts and crafts. Through our themed role-play, children will be able to act out using their own imagination.
