In English, we will be looking to write a range of texts. For fiction, we will be writing a rags to riches story; for non-fiction, we will be drafting and editing a persuasive letter; for poetry, we will be exploring performance choral poetry. In guided reading, we will be completing our text 'Holes' by Louis Sachar before exploring a range of smaller extracts based on a range of topics.

We will use these different texts to build our ability to predict and summarise key points, whilst also building our vocabulary. We will have daily spelling lessons and we will also be working on developing our handwriting and presentation skills.

Computing
