

English

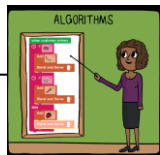
Our class book is 'Wendel's workshop by Chris Riddell. completing a variety of written activities inspired by the principles of heroism. Our non-fiction writing, will involve reading instructional texts and then writing instructions of our own. At the end of term, we will be focusing upon humorous poetry. In phonics, we will be using the Little Wandle scheme for our daily input. Following the scheme, pupils will be encouraged to segment and blend their sounds.

We will be exploring the question 'Why do people pray?' We will find out what prayer looks like in different religions.

Computing

This term we will be focusing on the concept of algorithms. Writing, following, creating and debugging algorithms.



Science

The children will continue to learn about animals including humans. They will be identifying and naming a variety of common animals such as mini-beasts and birds.



Maths

Our main focus for Term 3 is: Partitioning numbers beyond 10, recognising and identifying addition and subtraction facts. We will also be exploring measuring - comparing lengths, using non-standard units and common units to measure length and height.

PE

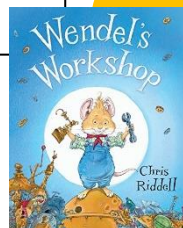
During P.E this term Miss Mewis will be teaching gymnastics through storytelling. Steven will be focusing on multi-skills - attacking and defending.
