

English

Our class book is 'Leaf' by Sandra Dieckmann. We will use this to plan and write a meeting tale. During this unit we will look at: using expanded noun phrases, verbs, subordinations as well as a variety of different punctuation. We will have daily spelling lessons this term. We will also continue to develop our handwriting ensuring we have consistent size and formation.

Maths

Our main units are:

- Multiplication and Division - the 2, 5 and 10 times table
- Length and Mass - capacity and weight.

History & Geography

We will learn about The Great Fire of London. We will focus on using sources to develop our understanding of the past, develop our sequencing and chronology and learn about what happened after the fire. We will also think about how the fire changed London and what London looks like today compared to the past.
