Our non-fiction writing will take on the form of a discussion and writing a balanced argument. Towards the end of the term, we will explore song lyrics and how they relate to poetry.

Our daily whole-class guided reading sessions we will be based around 'Goodnight Mister Tom' by Michelle Magorian. We will use this book to work on our inference skills and expand our vocabulary. We will also have daily spelling lessons and lessons on developing our handwriting and presentation skills.
