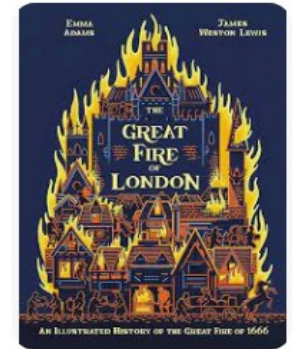


Elm Year 2 Term 3 Pick and Mix Homework

Can you sequence the key events that happened during the Great Fire of London? This could be in the form of a timeline either modelled, written, a powerpoint or a newspaper article .



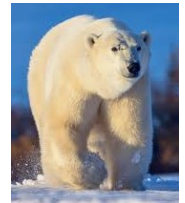
Maths

Research polar bears. Show us what you have found out however you wish! It could be a fact file, typed on the computer, a poster or a leaflet ...



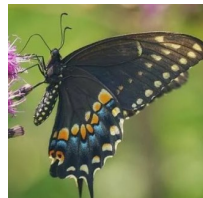
Music-
