

English

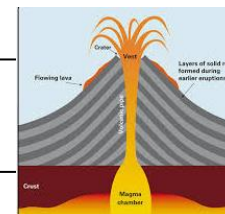

Spellings

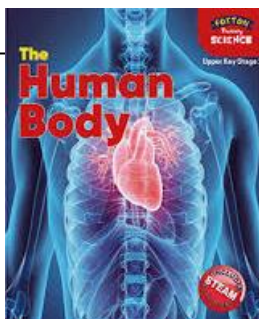
