

English

Our writing will be based on the book 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell. We will use the story to write our own Voyage and Return story during our fiction writing. Our non-fiction writing will take on the form of a persuasion text. Towards the end of term we will explore poetic language. During our daily whole-class guided reading sessions we will be sharing short texts and developing our skills in prediction and inference. We will have daily spelling lessons and we will also be working on developing our handwriting and presentation skills.

Maths

Our main focus in Maths will be fractions. We will explore equivalent fractions, improper fractions and mixed numbers, adding and subtracting fractions and fractions of an amount.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at why people live near volcanoes. We will learn about the Earth's layers, mountains and the effects of volcanic eruptions.
