

English

This term we are continuing to look at 'Darwin's Dragons'. We will be using the book to write a recount using the story as an example, exploring the language and vocabulary used in the book. We will also look at a day aboard the HMS Beagle. For non-fiction we will be writing instructions. We will be reading this together, in class, to build vocabulary and fluency when reading. We will also be taking part in daily spelling and grammar practice. In this term, we will also be practising and sitting the SATs papers.

Computing
