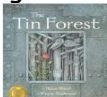


English

We will be looking closely at "The Tin Forest" by Helen Ward. This is a story with a moral. We will use this as a basis for planning and writing our creative stories. We will improve our writing skills by focusing on our editing skills to include the correct punctuation as well as using verbs, adverbs and conjunctions. We will be focusing on the importance of neat handwriting and presentation.

The children will be writing poetry using pictures as stimuli as well as their imaginations. The children will be writing a recount of class trip. We will have daily hand writing, spelling and reading lessons.



Maths

Year 2s — This term the Yr2 children will continue to secure their knowledge and understanding of multiplication, division and subtracting. They will be extending their learning in Geometry, fractions and solving word problem skills.

Year 1s—This term the Yr1 children will learning simple multiplications and division. They will be extending their understanding of money and giving change, in addition to extending their measuring skills of mass and capacity.

Geography

Our topic is "What is it like in to live in Shanghai?" We will be learning about human and physical features of a non-European country, using aerial photographs, maps and how to use a compass. We will be comparing Shanghai with our area of the UK. The children will learn about the different weather here with tropical weather, as well as, the different types of building e.g., cottages, barns, skyscrapers

Art

In Art we will making 3D maps using layering materials. We will be creating printing tiles and printings simple repeating patterns.

DT

In DT the children will be designing, making and evaluating our own fruit smoothies - **yummy!**

R.E.

Our learning this term is 'What did Jesus teach about God in his parables'. The children will be learning a variety of parables Jesus taught us e.g. The Good Samaritan, The Mustard Seed, The Prodigal Son, The Lost Sheep and discussing the messages within them.

Computing

The children will be learning word processing skills. Learning to type making changes such as bold, underline and italic. We will be importing images into documents to create a digital piece of writing.

Science

In term 6 we will be learning about Ocean protectors and studying micro-habitats such as rock pools. As well as learning how, human litter affects our oceans and the food chains within them. We learn the role of a marine biologist.

Music

Our music unit is called "Musical symbols" The children will be exploring pitch patterns. They will be composing musical patterns using simple notations.
