45th Brinkworth Annual Produce and Handicraft Show

Today, the children have been busy taking part in three activities at school for the upcoming **Brinkworth Annual Produce Show**. They have completed work for the following specific categories:

- **Class 91:** Decorate a wooden spoon
- **Class 94:** Design your own Football Shirt
- **Class 95:** Specimen handwriting

School Entries (Classes 91, 94, and 95)

As is tradition, **all children will be entered into the specimen handwriting competition (Class 95).**

If your child would like to formally enter their other two school creations (**Class 91 and Class 94**) into the show, please fill out and return the. If you choose to enter these, I will safely transport their sponge printing and decorated stones directly to the produce show for you.

The show takes place on **Sunday, 6th September 2026**. For any families who choose not to show their work, please rest assured that your child's creations will be safely returned to them at school after the event in September.

Entering Other Children's Classes

Children are also very welcome to enter any of the other classes in their respective age categories. If your child would like to submit an entry for any other classes, please list these on the entry form as well.

Please Note: Parents will need to bring any additional entries to the show marquee themselves. The drop-off and setup window is between **8:00am and 9:30am** on Sunday, 6th September 2026, at the Produce and Handicraft show marquee located on the **Brinkworth Recreation Field**.

For your reference, here is the full list of classes covering those ranges:

Section H: Older Primary School Children (Classes 87-95)

- **Class 87:** Miniature garden in a standard seed tray (max size 26cm x 38cm)
- **Class 87a:** Make a Bug House
- **Class 88:** Winnie-the-Pooh inspired picture (max A4 any medium)
- **Class 89:** A paper plane made from an A4 piece of paper (judged by flight distance on the morning of the show)
- **Class 90:** A Lego model no bigger than 31cm x 31cm please
- **Class 91:** Decorate a wooden spoon or wooden spatula
- **Class 92:** A person or animal out of fruit and/or vegetables
- **Class 93:** Posy of flowers in a mug
- **Class 94:** Design your own Football Shirt (drawn, painted, printed max size A4)
- **Class 94a:** 5 Cup Cakes any recipe (can include Gluten Free/Dairy Free/Vegan etc.)
- **Class 95:** Specimen handwriting – Key Stage 2 (Year 3, 4, 5 & 6)

Section J: Photography (Classes 96–99a)

- **Class 96:** Pet meme
- **Class 97:** Best photo bomb

Prizes and Trophies

Cash prizes are awarded for each individual children's class:

- **1st Prize:** £1
2nd Prize: 60p
3rd Prize: 40p

There are also **Highly Commended certificates**, alongside special **trophies** up for grabs for handwriting, photography, and the most points gained within the age range classes.

How to Submit Entry Forms

You have two options for returning your completed entry forms:

1. **Return to School:** Hand them back to the school office by **Friday, 17th July**.
2. **Deliver Directly:** Drop them off to **Cherry Trees, Stoppers Hill, Brinkworth, SN15 5DW** by no later than **4:00pm on Friday, 4th September 2026**.

If you choose to deliver the form directly to Cherry Trees yourself, please clearly write a note on the form to indicate that I already have your child's physical entries for Class 80, 83, and 86 so they can be matched up.
